



# WYOMING STREET WINE STOP

## Reds

**JAM JAR, SWEET SHIRAZ, SOUTH AFRICA**  
Crafted in a lighter style this Shiraz is a fresh, fruity, sweet wine that displays aromas and flavors of ripe blueberries, blackberries and raspberries with dark chocolate undertones. Refreshing and approachable with a perfect balance

**AVA GRACE MERLOT, CALIFORNIA, 2017**  
Bursting with aromas of deep red fruit that fill the nose. Silky on the palate and full of layers of black cherry, plum, and blueberry flavors delicately intermingled with notes of mocha, vanilla, and spice that lead into a long smooth finish

**R. SIGNATURE MERLOT, NAPA VALLEY, CALIFORNIA**  
Notes of Black fruits and chocolates bold but soft! Nice Californian red to enjoy

**INDABA MOSAIC RED BLEND, SOUTH AFRICA, 2018**  
This vibrant Bordeaux blend displays alluring aromas and juicy flavors of blackcurrant, ripe brambly berry fruit and dark chocolate, with subtle spice notes. Elegant, gentle tannins coat the palate, enticing you to take another sip!

**STONE HILL HELLBENDER, RED BLEND, MISSOURI**  
A smooth red blend with aromas of sweet cherry, blueberry and a touch of toasted oak. Creating a soft, complex and very drinkable wine, made from grapes all grown in the Ozark Mountain. \*A portion of the proceeds from every bottle of Ozark Hellbender wine sold is donated to the Saint Louis Zoo and hellbender conservation.

**ANDRE BRUNEL CÔTES DU RHÔNE VILLAGES CUVÉE SABRINE, FRANCE 2016**  
Solid wine, established notes and body yet very well balanced. Dry and acidic, plum, blackberry and black Cherry with leather earthy and smoke

**BEAUJOLAIS NOUVEAU, BURGUNDY, FRANCE, 2020**  
Beaujolais Nouveau Day is marked in France on the third Thursday in November, just weeks after the wine's grapes have been harvested. Parties are held throughout the country to celebrate the first wine of the season. A fresh, red-fruit-forward Beaujolais Nouveau with a lingering midpalate. Medium-intensity purple in color, this wine has an aromatic, medium-plus-intensity nose of dark berries, red cherry, strawberry and macerated raspberry.

**AUGUSTA CHAMBOURCIN, MISSOURI**  
Dry red wine made from the Chambourcin (sham-bor-san) grape. Deep burgundy in color with an aroma that is berry fruit, cassis, plum and licorice. The full body is rich, spicy and earthy followed by a jammy fruit finish that leaves a velvety

feel in the mouth. Chambourcin is very similar to a Merlot and is delicious with BBQ, steak and pork.

**TRAPICHE MALBEC, ARGENTINA, 2019**  
Aged in oak, deep red color with hints of tobacco smoke and red fruit on the nose. Rich plum, wood and vanilla on the palate.

**LA POSTA PIZZELLA, MALBEC, ARGENTINA, 2019**  
A beautiful red and purple color with aromas of black cherries, dark fruits, dark chocolate and baker's spice. On the palate, the wine shows dense, dark berry and plum flavors along with hints of sandalwood and spice, and even a hint of violets in the finish. This is a full-bodied and well-structured wine that is incredibly full of life and born to be enjoyed with food and friends

**LLAMA, OLD VINE MALBEC, ARGENTINA, 2018**  
With a bright red ruby color, this well-structured wine boasts lavish cherries, ripe raspberries and strawberries on the nose and in the mouth with a stylish and crisp finish.

**CULT CABERNET SAUVIGNON, CALIFORNIA, 2017**  
Palate is fruity forward, savory, rich and focused. This wine has dynamic length. Blend: 86% Cabernet Sauvignon, 8% Petit Verdot and 4% Petit Sirah  
Mint and new leather characters infuse this full bodied wine with a tantalizing complexity, while assertive black-fruit flavors flood the palate. It is moderately tannic and nicely layered.

**STAVE & STEEL CABERNET SAUVIGNON, CALIFORNIA, 2017**  
This Paso Robles Cabernet Sauvignon is aged for four months in flame-charred, formerly-used Kentucky Bourbon barrels, creating a refined, full-bodied wine with bold fruit flavors and a zesty Bourbon finish. The result is a refined, full-bodied Cabernet with bold fruit flavors. Dark cherry, blackberry and plum enrich the palate, providing excellent structure and generous tannins.  
The bourbon influences add notes of vanilla, caramel, and spice that lead into a long, smooth finish

**BONANZA, CABERNET SAUVIGNON, CALIFORNIA**  
Created by Chuck Wagner of Caymus Vineyards, this wine is delicious, accessible and enjoyable. Features flavors of luscious fruit, dark chocolate and silky tannins.

**MCMANIS PINOT NOIR, CALIFORNIA, 2019 LODI.** Light purple in color and is bursting with aroma and flavor, leading with ripe red cherry, strawberry cream, and raspberry notes. The wine is silky on the palate with red fruit and vanilla undertones, culminating in a clean, lasting finish.

BACKHOUSE PINOT NOIR, CALIFORNIA,  
2017

Stainless steel fermentation; aged on French oak.  
Soft and elegant with crimson color and flavors of plump red  
berries and dark cherry on the palate

ROCO, GRAVEL ROAD PINOT NOIR NV,  
OREGON

Aged on French Oak. Willamette Valley is punctuated by  
gravel roads, which lead to the regions finest vineyards.  
ROCO's Gravel Road Pinot Noir is a blend of several of the  
distinctive vineyards including the Soles' own Wits' End  
Vineyard in the Chehalem Mountains AVA. An outstanding  
value, the Gravel Road Pinot Noir flavor profile surpasses  
many other wineries flagship Pinot Noirs. The old world style  
offers bold flavor with balance and grace to pair well with  
nearly any food.

WINDRACER PINOT NOIR, ANDERSON  
VALLEY, CALIFORNIA, 2013

A lively red cherry and cranberry fruit profile evolves with  
intense grip and power on the palate. The bright texture  
extends across the long finish, carried by firm tannins and  
notes of clove and spice.

AUGUSTA NORTON, MISSOURI, 2017

Made from the Norton (which is also known as the Cynthiana)  
grape, this dry red wine is a beautiful deep burgundy color.  
The rich bouquet is that of raspberry and black cherry with a  
hint of cigar. The full body consists of cassis and black cherry  
with soft jammy overtones and is similar in style to a  
Cabernet, yet with the spiciness of a Zinfandel. The finish is  
lingering with hints of spice, vanilla and raspberries.  
Cynthiana is excellent with steak, duck, meaty stews and rich  
cheeses.
